Explanations

1. “an” (c)

We use 'an' before words that begin with a vowel sound. 'Apple' starts with the vowel sound /æ/.

2. “a” (a)

We use 'a' before words that begin with a consonant sound. 'University' starts with /juː/, which is a consonant sound, even though the letter is 'u'.

3. “a” (d)

We use 'a' before words that begin with a consonant sound. 'Glass' starts with the consonant sound /g/.
