# Explanations

**1. “He” (b)**

'My brother' is male and singular, so we use the subject pronoun 'he'.

**2. “They” (c)**

'The children' is plural, so we use 'they'.

**3. “I” (a)**

The verb 'am' is only used with the subject pronoun 'I'.

**4. “It” (a)**

We usually use 'it' for animals unless we know the gender or have a personal connection.

**5. “She” (d)**

'My mother' is female and singular, so we use 'she'.

**6. “We” (c)**

'Tom and I' includes the speaker, so we use 'we'.

**7. “It” (b)**

'The book' is a thing, so we use 'it'.

**8. “They” (c)**

'Lisa and Sarah' are two people (not including the speaker), so we use 'they'.

**9. “You” (a)**

The speaker is talking directly to someone, so we use 'you'.

**10. “He” (d)**

'My father' is male and singular, so we use 'he'.

**11. “It” (b)**

We use 'it' to talk about the weather.

**12. “They” (d)**

'My grandparents' is plural, so we use 'they'.

**13. “She” (a)**

'Maria' is a female name, so we use 'she'.

**14. “We” (c)**

'My classmates and I' includes the speaker, so we use 'we'.

**15. “They” (b)**

'The keys' is plural, so we use the subject pronoun 'they'.

**16. “He” (d)**

'Mr. Chen' is male (Mr. = a man), so we use 'he'.

**17. “It” (c)**

We usually use 'it' for animals in general contexts.

**18. “We” (d)**

The speaker says 'us' later in the sentence, which tells us the subject is 'we' (a group including the speaker).

**19. “They” (b)**

'Emma and Jack' are two people (not including the speaker), so we use 'they'.

**20. “It” (a)**

We use 'it' to talk about the time. 'It is 10 o'clock' is a fixed pattern.
