**1. “him” (b)**

Tom is a boy. Use 'him' after a verb.

**2. “her” (d)**

Amy is a girl. Use 'her' after a verb.

**3. “me” (c)**

Use 'me' after a verb. Help me.

**4. “them” (a)**

Two or more things = 'them'. I like them.

**5. “us” (c)**

Use 'us' for we. She likes us.

**6. “me” (a)**

Use 'me' after 'look at'. Look at me.

**7. “him” (b)**

Ben is a boy. Use 'him'. I can see him.

**8. “her” (a)**

Mum is a woman. Use 'her'. I love her.

**9. “it” (d)**

A ball is a thing. Use 'it'.

**10. “them” (c)**

Two people = 'them'. Look at them.

**11. “me” (d)**

Use 'me' after a verb. Dad helps me.

**12. “him” (a)**
