# Explanations

**1. “isn't she” (a)**

The statement uses 'is' (positive), so the tag must be negative: 'isn't she'. We repeat the same auxiliary verb in the tag.

**2. “are they” (d)**

The statement uses 'aren't' (negative), so the tag must be positive: 'are they'. Negative statement → positive tag.

**3. “don't you” (c)**

'You like' is present simple with no auxiliary verb, so we use 'do' for the tag. Positive statement → negative tag: 'don't you'.

**4. “does he” (d)**

'Doesn't speak' is negative present simple with 'does'. Negative → positive tag: 'does he'.

**5. “weren't they” (a)**

'Were' is past tense of 'be' (positive), so the tag is 'weren't they'. Match the tense of the main clause.

**6. “did he” (b)**

'Didn't call' is negative past simple. Negative → positive tag: 'did he'.

**7. “wasn't it” (c)**

'Was' is past tense of 'be' (positive). Positive → negative tag: 'wasn't it'.

**8. “don't they” (d)**

'Live' is present simple (positive, plural subject). No auxiliary → use 'do'. Positive → negative: 'don't they'.

**9. “was she” (a)**

'Wasn't' is negative past 'be'. Negative → positive tag: 'was she'.

**10. “do we” (b)**

'Don't need' is negative present simple. Negative → positive tag: 'do we'.

**11. “doesn't he” (d)**

'Works' is third-person singular present simple (positive). No auxiliary → use 'does'. Positive → negative: 'doesn't he'.

**12. “was it” (c)**

'Wasn't' is negative past 'be'. Negative → positive tag: 'was it'.

**13. “aren't you” (a)**

'Are coming' uses 'are' (positive present continuous). Positive → negative tag: 'aren't you'.

**14. “did they” (b)**

'Didn't finish' is negative past simple. Negative → positive tag: 'did they'.

**15. “isn't he” (c)**

'Is reading' uses 'is' (positive present continuous). Positive → negative tag: 'isn't he'.

**16. “do you” (c)**

'Don't eat' is negative present simple. Negative → positive tag: 'do you'.

**17. “didn't she” (a)**

'Played' is past simple (positive). No auxiliary → use 'did'. Positive → negative: 'didn't she'.

**18. “weren't they” (b)**

'Were' is past 'be' (positive). Positive → negative tag: 'weren't they'.

**19. “does it” (c)**

'Doesn't rain' is negative present simple. Negative → positive tag: 'does it'.

**20. “weren't you” (d)**

'Were waiting' uses 'were' (positive past continuous). Positive → negative tag: 'weren't you'.
