# Explanations

## 1. “aren't I” (b)

'I am' is a special case. The tag is 'aren't I' (not 'amn't I', which doesn't exist in standard English). This is the only irregular tag form.

## 2. “shall we” (d)

'Let's' (let us) always takes the tag 'shall we'. This is a fixed expression — 'shall we' is the only correct tag for 'let's'.

## 3. “aren't there” (a)

When the subject is 'there', the tag also uses 'there' (not 'they'). Positive → negative: 'aren't there'.

## 4. “don't they” (c)

Indefinite pronouns like 'everybody', 'everyone', 'somebody', 'someone' are replaced by 'they' in the tag. 'Everybody knows' is positive present simple → 'don't they'.

## 5. “will you” (a)

Imperative sentences (commands/requests) take the tag 'will you?' or 'won't you?'. Here 'will you' makes a polite request.

## 6. “did it” (c)

'Nothing' is treated as negative, and it is replaced by 'it' in the tag. Negative → positive: 'did it'.

## 7. “was there” (c)

'There wasn't' is negative. The tag uses 'there' as the subject. Negative → positive: 'was there'.

## 8. “did they” (d)

'Nobody' is negative and is replaced by 'they' in the tag. Negative → positive: 'did they'.

## 9. “am I” (d)

'I'm not' is negative 'I am'. For the negative form, the tag is simply 'am I' (positive). The 'aren't I' exception only applies to positive 'I am'.

## 10. “shall we” (a)

Both 'Let's' and 'Let's not' take the same tag: 'shall we'. This is always fixed regardless of whether 'let's' is positive or negative.

## 11. “didn't they” (b)

'Someone' is an indefinite pronoun replaced by 'they' in the tag. 'Left' is positive past simple → negative tag: 'didn't they'.

## 12. “isn't there” (b)

'There is' (positive) → negative tag: 'isn't there'. Use 'there' in the tag, not 'it'.

## 13. “will you” (c)

Negative imperatives ('Don't ...') also take the tag 'will you'. This is the standard tag for all imperative sentences.

## 14. “isn't it” (c)

'Everything' is replaced by 'it' in the tag (not 'they'). 'Is' is positive → negative tag: 'isn't it'.

## 15. “aren't I” (d)

'I'm' = 'I am' (positive). The special tag for positive 'I am' is 'aren't I'.

**16. “will there” (a)**

'There won't be' is negative future with 'there' as subject. Negative → positive: 'will there'.

**17. “did they” (a)**

'No one' is negative and is replaced by 'they' in the tag. Negative → positive: 'did they'.

**18. “won't you” (d)**

This is a polite imperative (invitation). 'Won't you' is used with positive imperatives to add a warm, inviting tone:  
'Have a seat, won't you?'

**19. “doesn't it” (b)**

'Something' is replaced by 'it' in the tag. 'Smells' is positive present simple (third person) → 'doesn't it'.

**20. “haven't there” (b)**

'There have been' is positive present perfect with 'there' as subject. Positive → negative: 'haven't there'.
