# Explanations

**1. “is” (a)**

One cat = 'is'. There is a cat on the bed.

**2. “are” (d)**

Two dogs = 'are'. There are two dogs.

**3. “is” (c)**

One book = 'is'. There is a book.

**4. “are” (b)**

Three birds = 'are'. There are three birds.

**5. “is” (d)**

One ball = 'is'. There is a ball.

**6. “are” (a)**

Some flowers = more than one. Use 'are'.

**7. “is” (a)**

One pen = 'is'. There is a pen in my bag.

**8. “are” (c)**

Five eggs = 'are'. There are five eggs.

**9. “is” (d)**
