Explanations

1. “will be lying” (a)

Use 'will be + -ing' for an action in progress at a specific future time. 'This time tomorrow' indicates a moment in the future.

2. “will be having” (b)

Future Continuous 'will be having' shows an action in progress at 8 pm tonight.

3. “will be travelling” (c)

'Next week at this time' signals a specific moment in the future when the action will be ongoing.

4. “will be working on” (d)

'All day tomorrow' indicates a continuous action throughout the day, requiring Future Continuous.

5. “will be studying” (a)

Future Continuous describes what will be happening at a specific point in the future.

6. “will be playing” (b)

'In an hour' points to a future moment when the playing will be in progress.

7. “will be sleeping” (c)

At a specific time (midnight), the action of sleeping will be ongoing.

8. “will be working” (d)

'This time next year' requires Future Continuous for an action in progress at that moment.

9. “will be having” (a)

The lunch will be in progress when the arrival happens.

10. “will be arriving” (b)

'At this time in ten minutes' points to a specific moment when the arrival will be in progress, requiring Future Continuous.

11. “will be taking” (c)

At a specific time (3 o'clock), the test-taking will be in progress.

12. “will be driving” (d)

'At 7 am tomorrow' specifies a precise future moment when the driving will be in progress, requiring Future Continuous.

13. “will be painting” (a)

'At this time tomorrow' indicates a future moment when painting will be in progress.

14. “will be relaxing” (b)

'All day' emphasizes the continuous nature of the action.

15. “will be preparing” (c)

At noon, the preparation will be ongoing.

16. “will be watching” (d)

'At 9 pm this evening' pinpoints a specific moment when watching will be in progress, requiring Future Continuous.

17. “will be flying” (a)

'At this time next autumn' signals a specific future moment.

18. “will be playing” (b)

'At this time in two hours' specifies a precise future moment when the game will be in progress, requiring Future Continuous.

19. “will be finishing” (c)

The report-finishing will be in progress when the call comes.

20. “will be working” (d)

At the specific time of sunrise, working will be ongoing.
