# Explanations

**1. “Will” (a)**

Future Continuous questions start with 'Will' + subject + 'be' + verb-ing.

**2. “meeting” (b)**

After 'Will + subject + be', use the -ing form of the verb.

**3. “they will” (c)**

Short answer to a Future Continuous question uses 'will': Yes, they will.

**4. “he won't” (d)**

Negative short answer: No, he won't (= will not).

**5. “What” (a)**

'What' asks about the activity that will be in progress at 8 pm.

**6. “will” (b)**

Wh- questions in Future Continuous: Wh- word + will + subject + be + -ing.

**7. “using” (c)**

The structure is 'Will + subject + be + verb-ing'.

**8. “giving” (d)**

After 'will be', use the -ing form: giving.

**9. “they will” (a)**

Affirmative short answer: Yes, they will.

**10. “Where” (b)**

'Where' asks about the location where she will be waiting. The structure is: Wh- word + will + subject + be + -ing.

**11. “raining” (c)**

Use the -ing form after 'will be'.

**12. “they won't” (d)**

Negative short answer: No, they won't.

**13. “What” (a)**

'What time' asks about the specific time of arrival.

**14. “will” (b)**

The question structure is: How long + will + subject + be + -ing.

**15. “taking” (c)**

Use the -ing form (taking) after 'will be'.

**16. “it will” (d)**

The team (it) will be practising. Short answer: Yes, it will.

**17. “Who” (a)**

'Who' asks about the person doing the action.

**18. “I won't” (b)**

Negative short answer: No, I won't.

**19. “When” (c)**

'When' asks about the time the concert will be starting. The structure is: Wh- word + will + subject + be + -ing.

**20. “going” (d)**

After 'will be', use the -ing form: going.
