Explanations

1. “won't have finished” (c)

Use 'won't have finished' (will not have + past participle) for negative Future Perfect.

2. “Will ... have completed” (a)

Future Perfect questions use 'Will + subject + have + past participle'.

3. “won't have arrived” (d)

'Won't have arrived' shows they will not complete arriving before the movie begins.

4. “Will ... have earned” (b)

Question form: 'Will she have earned' asks about completion before next summer.

5. “won't have gotten” (c)

'Won't have gotten' indicates insufficient sleep before morning.

6. “they will” (a)

Short answer to 'Will they have...?' is 'Yes, they will.' or 'No, they won't.'

7. “won't have sold” (b)

Negative Future Perfect 'won't have sold' shows incomplete sales before that time.

8. “Will ... have constructed” (d)

Future Perfect question: 'Will the workers have constructed...'

9. “won't have melted” (a)

'Won't have melted' predicts the snow will still be there in April.

10. “I won't” (c)

Negative short answer to 'Will you have...?' is 'No, I won't.'

11. “Will ... have prepared” (b)

Question form asks if meal preparation will be complete before guest arrival.

12. “won't have completed” (d)

'By the cutoff time' sets a deadline, requiring Future Perfect. 'Won't have completed' shows she will not finish the marathon before that deadline.

13. “he will” (a)

Affirmative short answer: 'Yes, he will.'

14. “won't have arrived” (b)

'Won't have arrived' indicates the package will not be there before Friday.

15. “Will ... have cooked” (c)

Future Perfect question: 'Will you have cooked dinner by...?'

16. “won't have analyzed” (d)

'Won't have analyzed' expresses that the analysis will be incomplete.

17. “they won't” (a)

Negative short answer: 'No, they won't.'

18. “Will ... have made” (b)

Future Perfect question asking about a completed decision before next week.

19. “won't have done” (c)

'By tomorrow' sets a deadline, requiring Future Perfect. 'Won't have done' shows the homework will remain incomplete before that deadline.

20. “she will” (d)

Affirmative short answer to Future Perfect question: 'Yes, she will.'
