# Explanations

**1. “will be doing” (c)**

Use Future Continuous 'will be doing' for an action in progress at a specific time.

**2. “will have done” (a)**

Use Future Perfect 'will have done' for an action completed before a deadline.

**3. “will be relaxing” (d)**

'This time next week' indicates an action in progress — use Future Continuous.

**4. “will have been” (b)**

'By this time' + duration indicates completed time — use Future Perfect.

**5. “will be having” (c)**

'At 3 pm' + 'then' shows an action in progress — Future Continuous.

**6. “will have finished” (a)**

'By then' indicates completion — use Future Perfect 'will have finished'.

**7. “will be going on” (b)**

The party will be in progress at midnight — use Future Continuous.

**8. “will have gone” (d)**

'By midnight' shows departure will be complete — Future Perfect.

**9. “will be taking” (a)**

'This time tomorrow' = action in progress — Future Continuous.

**10. “will have taken” (c)**

'By this time tomorrow' = action completed — Future Perfect.

**11. “will be preparing” (b)**

'At this time in an hour' indicates an action in progress at a specific point — use Future Continuous 'will be preparing'.

**12. “will have prepared” (d)**

'By the time' indicates completion before arrival — Future Perfect.

**13. “will be sleeping” (a)**

At a specific time, the action is in progress — Future Continuous.

**14. “will have slept” (b)**

'By 6 am' + duration = completed time — Future Perfect.

**15. “will be having” (c)**

The action will be in progress when you arrive — Future Continuous.

**16. “will have had” (d)**

The dinner will be complete before arrival — Future Perfect.

**17. “will be flying” (a)**

'At this hour' next month = action in progress — Future Continuous.

**18. “will have traveled” (b)**

'By next month' + count = completed achievement — Future Perfect.

**19. “will be studying” (c)**

At a specific time, studying is in progress — Future Continuous.

**20. “will have reviewed” (d)**

'By 9 pm' indicates the review will be complete — Future Perfect.
