Explanations

1. “will have worked” (c)

'By the time I retire' + duration = completed period — Future Perfect.

2. “Will ... have finished” (a)

Future Perfect question: 'Will you have finished...by...?'

3. “will have ended” (c)

'By the time we get home' indicates completion — Future Perfect.

4. “will have learned” (b)

'By the time she's 25' + accomplishment = Future Perfect.

5. “won't have cooked” (c)

Negative Future Perfect: 'won't have cooked' — not complete before arrival.

6. “will have replaced” (a)

'By 2050' sets the deadline for complete replacement — Future Perfect.

7. “will be living” (b)

'At this time' = action in progress — Future Continuous.

8. “Will ... have landed” (d)

Future Perfect question about a completed event by a future date.

9. “will have made” (a)

'By the end of this meeting' = deadline for completion — Future Perfect.

10. “will have sent” (b)

'Before you even get a chance' sets a future deadline. 'Will have sent' (Future Perfect) shows the email will already be completed before that point.

11. “will have melted” (b)

'By 2100' indicates the melting will be complete — Future Perfect.

12. “will have been waiting” (d)

'By the time' + duration of an ongoing action = Future Perfect Continuous.

13. “won't have completed” (a)

'By the December deadline' requires Future Perfect. 'Won't have completed' shows the bridge will not be finished before that deadline.

14. “will ... have visited” (b)

Future Perfect question about accumulated travel by age 40.

15. “will be taking” (c)

'This time next week' = action in progress — Future Continuous.

16. “will have set” (d)

'By 8 pm' indicates the sunset will be complete — Future Perfect.

17. “will have published” (a)

'By the time she turns 50' = deadline for publication — Future Perfect.

18. “won't have arrived” (b)

'By Friday' sets a deadline, requiring Future Perfect. 'Won't have arrived' shows the package will not have been delivered before that date.

19. “will have figured out” (d)

'By the time' + future event = completion before that event — Future Perfect.

20. “Will ... have fixed” (d)

Future Perfect question: 'Will the work be complete before we move in?'
