Explanations

1. “am” (a)

Use Present Continuous (am + -ing) for fixed arrangements with a specific time. 'We arranged it yesterday' confirms this is a definite arrangement.

2. “will” (b)

Instant decision in response to a situation = use 'will'.

3. “are” (c)

Use Present Continuous (are + -ing) for fixed arrangements. 'It's all arranged' confirms this is a definite plan.

4. “is going to” (d)

Intention based on prior decision = 'be going to'.

5. “am” (d)

Ticket booked = fixed arrangement = Present Continuous.

6. “will” (c)

Opinion about future weather = 'will'.

7. “are” (a)

Confirmed appointment = fixed arrangement = Present Continuous.

8. “is going to” (d)

Evidence (clouds) = prediction = 'be going to'.

9. “are” (b)

Asking about an arrangement = Present Continuous.

10. “am going to” (d)

Decision made before speaking = 'be going to'.

11. “is” (b)

New job with set start date = fixed arrangement = Present Continuous.

12. “will” (d)

Spontaneous offer = 'will'.

13. “are” (c)

Venue booked = fixed arrangement = Present Continuous.

14. “will” (c)

General prediction about distant future = 'will'.

15. “are” (d)

Asking about arrangements = Present Continuous.

16. “are going to” (c)

Months of planning = intention = 'be going to'.

17. “am” (a)

Specific time arranged = Present Continuous.

18. “will” (d)

Decision made now while choosing = 'will'.

19. “is” (c)

Scheduled transport = Present Continuous (or Present Simple).

20. “am going to” (d)

Prior thought/decision = 'be going to'.
