Explanations

1. “Were” (a)

Use 'Were' to form questions with 'you'.

2. “Was” (a)

Use 'Was' to form questions with 'she'.

3. “Were / were” (b)

Use 'Were' for questions with plural subjects. Short answer: Yes, they were.

4. “Was / wasn't” (b)

Use 'Was' for 'it'. Negative short answer: No, it wasn't.

5. “Was” (b)

Use 'Was' to form questions with 'he'.

6. “Were / were” (d)

Use 'Were' for 'they'. Short answer: Yes, they were.

7. “Was / weren't” (b)

Use 'Was' for 'I'. Answer about 'you': No, you weren't.

8. “Were” (a)

Use 'Were' for plural subjects like 'your parents' (= they).

9. “Was / was” (d)

Use 'Was' for singular subjects. Short answer: Yes, it was.

10. “Were / weren't” (a)

Use 'Were' for 'we'. Negative short answer: No, we weren't.

11. “Was” (c)

Use 'Was' for singular subjects like 'the train' (= it).

12. “Were / was” (b)

Question with 'you' uses 'Were'. Answer about 'I' uses 'was'.

13. “Was” (b)

Use 'Was' to form questions with 'Sarah' (= she).

14. “Were / weren't” (d)

Use 'Were' for 'the kids' (= they). Negative: No, they weren't.

15. “Was” (a)

Use 'Was' with 'anyone' (grammatically singular).

16. “Were / were” (c)

Use 'Were' for compound subjects like 'Tom and Lisa' (= they).

17. “Was” (b)

Use 'Was' for 'the music' (= it).

18. “Was / weren't” (a)

Use 'Was' for 'I'. Answer about 'you': No, you weren't.

19. “Was” (a)

Use 'Was' for collective nouns like 'the team' (British English may use 'Were').

20. “Was / was” (a)

Use 'Was' with 'everybody' (grammatically singular).
