Explanations

1. “hadn't been sleeping” (b)

Use 'hadn't been sleeping' (negative Past Perfect Continuous) to explain the cause of feeling tired.

2. “Had ... been waiting” (a)

Use 'Had you been waiting' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because the visible evidence ('looked frozen') points to an ongoing action before a past event ('the bus came').

3. “hadn't been practising” (a)

Use 'hadn't been practising' to show insufficient preparation before a past result.

4. “had ... been learning” (d)

Use 'How long + had + subject + been + verb-ing?' to ask about duration before a past event.

5. “hadn't been feeling” (c)

Use 'hadn't been feeling' to describe an ongoing negative state before a past action.

6. “Had ... been raining” (c)

Use 'Had + subject + been + verb-ing?' for yes/no questions about ongoing past actions.

7. “hadn't been working” (c)

Use 'hadn't been working' to show a short duration before a past event.

8. “had ... been doing” (a)

Use 'What had you been doing' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because 'all evening' emphasizes the duration of an ongoing activity before a past moment ('I called').

9. “hadn't been expecting” (c)

Use 'hadn't been expecting' (Past Perfect Continuous) to describe an ongoing mental state before a past event ('when the results came in').

10. “Had ... been playing” (b)

Use 'Had the children been playing' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because the visible evidence ('filthy when they came in') points to an ongoing activity before a past moment.

11. “hadn't been paying” (d)

Use 'hadn't been paying' (Past Perfect Continuous) because 'for the entire meeting' emphasizes the duration of inattention before the consequence ('missed the important announcement').

12. “had ... been staying” (d)

Use 'Where had they been staying' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because 'for all those months' emphasizes the duration of the temporary living situation before a past event ('found an apartment').

13. “hadn't been performing” (b)

Use 'hadn't been performing' to describe a negative trend before a past decision.

14. “had ... been dating” (d)

Use 'How long had you been dating' (Past Perfect Continuous question) to ask about the duration of an ongoing action before a past event ('got engaged'). 'Would ... date' is grammatically wrong here, and Present Perfect ('Have ... been dating') does not fit a completed past situation.

15. “hadn't been exercising” (b)

Use 'hadn't been exercising' to explain the cause of health issues.

16. “Had ... been looking” (c)

Use 'Had + subject + been + verb-ing?' to ask if an action was in progress.

17. “hadn't been investing” (a)

Use 'hadn't been investing' to explain a past consequence of inaction.

18. “had ... been crying” (d)

Use 'Why had she been crying' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because the visible evidence ('eyes were red') points to an ongoing action before a past moment ('you arrived').

19. “hadn't been communicating” (a)

Use 'hadn't been communicating' to describe a negative ongoing situation.

20. “Had ... been studying” (b)

Use 'Had the students been studying' (Past Perfect Continuous question) because 'for weeks' emphasizes the duration of the ongoing action before a past event ('the exam').
