# Explanations

1. **“went” (a)**  
go → went (irregular). This is one of the most common irregular verbs.
2. **“had” (d)**  
have → had (irregular).
3. **“did” (c)**  
do → did (irregular).
4. **“saw” (b)**  
see → saw (irregular).
5. **“came” (c)**  
come → came (irregular).
6. **“got” (b)**  
get → got (irregular).
7. **“made” (a)**  
make → made (irregular).
8. **“took” (a)**  
take → took (irregular).
9. **“ate” (b)**  
eat → ate (irregular). Pronounced /et/.
10. **“drank” (a)**  
drink → drank (irregular). Note: 'drunk' is the past participle.
11. **“gave” (c)**  
give → gave (irregular).
12. **“said” (a)**  
say → said (irregular). Pronounced /sed/.
13. **“knew” (b)**  
know → knew (irregular).
14. **“thought” (c)**  
think → thought (irregular).
15. **“found” (c)**  
find → found (irregular).
16. **“told” (a)**  
tell → told (irregular).
17. **“left” (d)**  
leave → left (irregular).

**18. “put” (b)**

put → put (irregular). The form doesn't change!

**19. “read” (a)**

read → read (irregular). The spelling is the same but pronunciation changes: /ri:d/ → /red/.

**20. “wrote” (c)**

write → wrote (irregular).
