Explanations

1. “Are” (a)

Use 'Are' at the start of yes/no questions with 'you'.

2. “Is” (d)

Use 'Is' at the start of yes/no questions with he/she/it.

3. “Are” (c)

Use 'Are' at the start of yes/no questions with they/we/you.

4. “Am” (b)

Use 'Am' at the start of yes/no questions with 'I'.

5. “Is” (c)

Use 'Is' because 'the baby' is third person singular.

6. “is” (a)

Short answer: 'Yes, he is.' Use the same auxiliary verb.

7. “am not” (d)

Short answer: 'No, I am not.' Use 'am not' with 'I' in negative short answers.

8. “are” (c)

Short answer: 'Yes, they are.' Use the same auxiliary verb.

9. “isn't” (b)

Short answer: 'No, it isn't.' Use 'isn't' with it/he/she in negative short answers.

10. “Are” (d)

Use 'Are' at the start of yes/no questions with 'we'.

11. “is” (b)

Short answer: 'Yes, she is.'

12. “aren't” (a)

Short answer: 'No, they aren't.' Use 'aren't' with they/we/you in negative short answers.

13. “Is” (b)

Use 'Is' because 'the dog' is third person singular.

14. “are” (d)

Short answer: 'Yes, you are.' When someone asks 'Am I...?', you answer with 'you are/aren't'.

15. “Are” (a)

Use 'Are' because 'your parents' is plural (= they).

16. “isn't” (b)

Short answer: 'No, he isn't.'

17. “Am” (c)

Use 'Am' at the start of yes/no questions with 'I'.

18. “am” (c)

Short answer: 'Yes, I am.'

19. “Is” (d)

Use 'Is' because 'the train' is third person singular.

20. “aren't” (b)

Short answer: 'No, you aren't.' When someone asks 'Are we...?', you answer with 'you are/aren't'.
