1. “have” (c)

Use 'have' with the subject 'I'.

2. “has” (b)

Use 'has' with he/she/it.

3. “have” (d)

Use 'have' with 'they'.

4. “has” (c)

Use 'has' with 'he'. The past participle of 'eat' is 'eaten'.

5. “have” (a)

Use 'have' with 'we'. The past participle of 'see' is 'seen'.

6. “has” (c)

Use 'has' because 'the cat' is third person singular (= it). 'Drunk' is the past participle of 'drink'.

7. “have” (b)

Use 'have' with 'you'. The past participle of 'do' is 'done'.

8. “have” (a)

Use 'have' because 'my parents' is plural (= they). 'Bought' is the past participle of 'buy'.

9. “has” (b)

Use 'has' with 'it'.

10. “have” (d)

Use 'have' with 'I'. 'Known' is the past participle of 'know'.

11. “has” (b)

Use 'has' with 'she'. 'Written' is the past participle of 'write'.

12. “have” (a)

Use 'have' because 'the children' is plural (= they). 'Gone' is the past participle of 'go'.

13. “has” (b)

Use 'has' because 'my brother' is third person singular (= he).

14. “have” (d)

Use 'have' with 'we'. 'Met' is the past participle of 'meet'.
