**4. “never” (d)**

Use 'never' to say this is their first time (they haven't done it before).

**5. “ever” (b)**

Use 'ever' in questions about experiences.

**6. “never” (b)**

Use 'never' to emphasize this is the most beautiful sunset you've seen.

**7. “ever” (a)**

Use 'ever' after superlatives (the best... I have ever...) to mean 'at any time'.
