Explanations

1. “always” (a)

Frequency adverbs like 'always' come before the main verb: She always gets up early.

2. “am never” (a)

With 'be', the adverb comes after: I am never late.

3. “usually cleans” (a)

Adverb before main verb + third person singular -s: He usually cleans.

4. “rarely” (c)

'Rarely' means not very often, which matches 'once a year'.

5. “is always” (a)

With 'be', frequency adverbs come after: She is always happy.

6. “seldom” (d)

'Seldom' means rarely/not often, matching 'prefer home cooking'.

7. “never has” (a)

Frequency adverb before main verb + third person form: She never has breakfast.

8. “often” (a)

'How often' asks about frequency.

9. “sometimes makes” (a)

Adverb before verb + third person singular: My brother sometimes makes his bed.

10. “twice” (b)

'Twice a week' means two times per week. 'Two time' is incorrect.

11. “usually go” (a)

Adverb before verb + base form for plural subjects: The children usually go.

12. “always” (a)

'Always' indicates something done every time, before the main verb.

13. “always” (d)

'Every day' indicates it happens all the time = always.

14. “are usually” (a)

With 'be', the adverb comes after: We are usually busy.

15. “always” (a)

'Always' fits between subject and main verb for habits.

16. “every” (a)

'Every month' is the correct time expression for regular meetings.

17. “Does” (b)

In questions with frequency adverbs, use Does + subject + adverb + base verb.

18. “do” (a)

Use 'do' in Wh- questions with 'you'. The adverb 'usually' goes after the subject.

19. “is not always” (a)

Negative with be + frequency adverb: is not always. The adverb goes between 'not' and the adjective.

20. “am never” (a)

With 'be', the adverb comes after: I am never late.
