# Explanations

**1. “goes” (b)**

Use 'goes' for third person singular (she).

**2. “drink” (a)**

Use the base form 'drink' for plural subjects (they).

**3. “reads” (b)**

Use 'reads' because 'my father' is third person singular (= he).

**4. “speak” (a)**

Use the base form 'speak' with 'I'.

**5. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' for third person singular (he).

**6. “play” (a)**

Use the base form 'play' with 'we'.

**7. “sleeps” (b)**

Use 'sleeps' because 'the dog' is third person singular (= it).

**8. “run” (a)**

Use the base form 'run' with 'you'.

**9. “works” (b)**

Use 'works' because 'my sister' is third person singular (= she).

**10. “play” (a)**

Use 'play' because 'the children' is plural (= they).

**11. “has” (b)**

Use 'has' for third person singular. 'Have' is irregular: have → has.

**12. “goes” (b)**

Use 'goes' because 'Tom' is third person singular (= he).

**13. “live” (a)**

Use 'live' because 'my parents' is plural (= they).

**14. “teaches” (b)**

Use 'teaches' because 'the teacher' is third person singular.

**15. “have” (a)**

Use 'have' with 'I'.

**16. “fly” (a)**

Use 'fly' because 'birds' is plural (= they).

**17. “works” (b)**

Use 'works' for third person singular (she).

**18. “play” (a)**

Use 'play' because 'my friends' is plural (= they).

**19. “goes” (b)**

Use 'goes' because 'this bus' is third person singular (= it).

**20. “read” (a)**

Use 'read' with 'you'. Note: 'readed' is incorrect — 'read' is an irregular verb.
