Explanations

1. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' for negative sentences with he/she/it.

2. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' for negative sentences with they/we/you/I.

3. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'I'.

4. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' with 'he'. The verb stays as 'have', not 'has'.

5. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'we'.

6. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' because 'my cat' is third person singular (= it).

7. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'you'.

8. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' because 'the shop' is third person singular. Note: 'open' stays in base form.

9. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' because 'Tom' is third person singular (= he).

10. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' because 'my parents' is plural (= they).

11. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' with 'she'. The verb stays as 'smoke', not 'smokes'.

12. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'I'.

13. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' because 'this machine' is third person singular (= it).

14. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'we'.

15. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' with 'he'. The verb stays as 'want', not 'wants'.

16. “don't” (a)

Use 'don't' because 'the children' is plural (= they).

17. “doesn't” (b)

Use 'doesn't' with 'it'.

18. “don’t” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'you'.

19. “doesn’t” (b)

Use 'doesn't' because 'my brother' is third person singular (= he).

20. “don’t” (a)

Use 'don't' with 'they'.
