# Explanations

**1. “Do” (a)**

Use 'Do' to form questions with you/we/they/I.

**2. “Does” (b)**

Use 'Does' to form questions with he/she/it.

**3. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' because 'your brother' is third person singular (= he). The main verb stays as 'live', not 'lives'.

**4. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' because 'the bank' is third person singular.

**5. “Do” (a)**

Use 'Do' because the subject is 'they'.

**6. “do” (a)**

Use 'do' in Wh- questions with 'you'.

**7. “Does” (b)**

Use 'Does' because the subject is 'it'.

**8. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' because 'this word' is third person singular.

**9. “Do” (a)**

Use 'Do' because 'your parents' is plural (= they).

**10. “do” (a)**

Use 'do' in Wh- questions with 'you'.

**11. “do” (a)**

Short answer: Yes, I do. / No, I don't.

**12. “doesn't” (b)**

Short answer: No, he doesn't.

**13. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' in Wh- questions with 'she'.

**14. “do” (a)**

Short answer: Yes, they do. (Not 'Yes, they have'.)

**15. “do” (a)**

Use 'do' in Wh- questions with 'you'.

**16. “Does” (b)**

Use 'Does' because 'the train' is third person singular (= it).

**17. “do” (a)**

Use 'do' with 'you'. Note: the first 'do' is the auxiliary; the second 'do' is the main verb.

**18. “doesn't” (b)**

Short answer: No, she doesn't.

**19. “does” (b)**

Use 'does' because 'this shirt' is third person singular.

**20. “Do” (a)**

Use 'Do' to form questions with 'I'.
