Explanations

1. “know” (a)

'Know' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: I know. (Not: I am knowing.)

2. “belongs” (c)

'Belong' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple + third person -s: belongs. (Not: is belonging.)

3. “prefers” (d)

'Prefer' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: She prefers.

4. “does” (b)

'Cost' is a stative verb. Form questions with does + base verb: does ... cost.

5. “believe” (a)

'Believe' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: I believe.

6. “owns” (b)

'Own' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: She owns. (Not: She is owning.)

7. “wants” (a)

'Want' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: He wants. (Not: He is wanting.)

8. “agree” (d)

'Agree' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: I agree.

9. “tastes” (a)

When 'taste' describes a quality, it's stative: This soup tastes delicious.

10. “loves” (d)

'Love' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: She loves.

11. “don't know” (b)

'Know' is a stative verb. Negative: I don't know. (Not: I am not knowing.)

12. “contains” (a)

'Contain' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: The box contains.

13. “seems” (b)

'Seem' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: He seems.

14. “don't remember” (d)

'Remember' is a stative verb. Negative: I don't remember.

15. “means” (d)

'Mean' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: This word means.

16. “need” (c)

'Need' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: They need. (Not: They are needing.)

17. “Do” (c)

'Understand' is a stative verb. Questions use Do/Does: Do you understand?

18. “hate” (b)

'Hate' is a stative verb. Use Present Simple: I hate.

19. “looks” (c)

When 'look' means 'appear/seem', it's stative: She looks very young.

20. “thinks” (c)

When 'think' means 'believe/have an opinion', it's stative: He thinks exercise is important. (But: He is thinking about the problem — action, not stative.)
